Construction - 10 elements, 6 groups

Angular field - 93°

Minimum focusing distance - 0.16m

Diaphragm action - Fully automatic

Minimum aperture - f/22

Filter size - 77mm screw-in type

Push-on diameter - 80mm

Weight - 320g

Barrel length - 59mm

Description - The first model of this lens was finished in bright flutings on both focussing and aperture rings, and has normal coating. Then it was revised as a multi-coated, all-black version with checkerboard-type focussing grip. Replaced by 2.8/20.


