Push-on diameter - 51mm

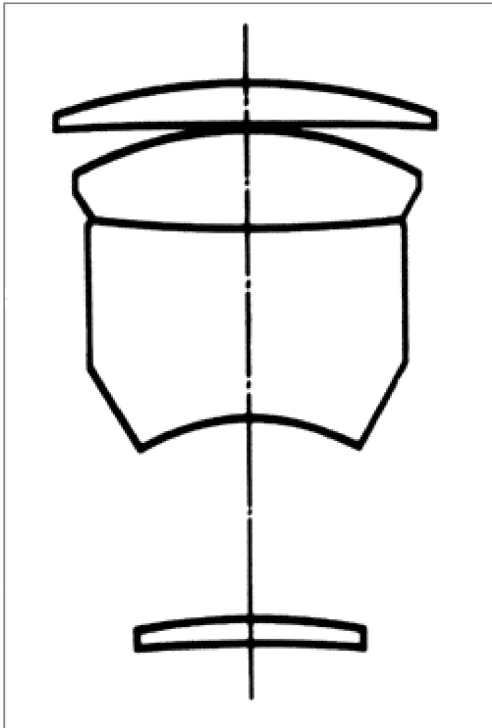

Description - Replacing the Sonnar 4/135, this lens was made in the multi-coated period, equipped with automatic aperture correction throughout the focussing range. Also remounted for the B-series as the Carl Zeiss Jena 135/3.5
