Construction - 5 elements, 5 groups

Angular field - 12°

Minimum focusing distance - 2.5m (pre-set), 2.7m (auto)

Diaphragm action - Pre-set / Fully automatic

Minimum aperture - f/22

Filter size - 58mm screw-in type

Push-on diameter - 60mm


Weight - 600g (pre-set), 670g (auto)

Barrel length - 134mm (pre-set), ?mm (auto)

Special features - detachable lens hood, interchangeable adapter

Description - This lens followed the same development as the 135/2.8.
The auto version appeared much later, with multi-coating
and made in auto and electric forms.
