Angular field - 24°

Minimum focusing distance - 1.1m

Diaphragm action - Manual / Fully automatic

Description - A smaller version of the Orestor 2.8/135, first produced with bright fluting and manual diaphragm. Then followed by fully automatic and electric versions, then finally with multi-coating.
